
Subject: Economy in use of paper – Digitisation of publications to save on stationery and expenditure.

Ministry of Finance has been issuing instructions from time to time on expenditure management, fiscal discipline and on the need for economy and rationalisation of Government expenditure. Instructions on use of judicious use of paper have been issued by this Department in the past and similar instructions are also contained in the Manual of Office Procedure published by Department of Administrative Reforms and Public Grievances.

2. Expenditure Management Commission has also recommended that publications should be digitised wherever possible, to save on stationery and expenditure. Considering that electronic publications (e-publications) are environment friendly, all Ministries / Departments may review the utilisation of their different publications and, to start with, e-publish some of their non-Statutory publications while considerably reducing use of paper e-publications would also serve as a good digital repository for posterity that can be accessed anywhere unlike manual publications.

3. All Ministries / Departments may issue suitable instructions in this regard in respect of organisations / entities and field organisations under their administrative control.

NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 28th November, 2016

G.S.R 1098(E).—In pursuance of the provisions of rule 45 of the Fundamental Rules, the President hereby makes the following further amendments to the Allotment of Government Residences (General Pool in Delhi) Rules 1963, namely :-

1. (1) These rules may be called the Allotment of Government Residences (General Pool in Delhi) Amendment Rules, 2016.
- (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. In the Allotment of Government Residences (General Pool in Delhi) Rules 1963, (hereinafter referred to as the said rules), for supplementary rule SR 317-B-5, the following rule shall be substituted, namely:—

S.R. 317-B-5 Classification of residences.—(1) Save as otherwise provided in these rules, an applicant shall be eligible for allotment of residence of the type as shown in column(1) as per the level in the pay matrix specified in the corresponding column(3), in the table below:-

(2) Save as otherwise provided in these rules, an allottee shall be eligible for allotment of hostel accommodation as shown in column(1) as per the level in the pay matrix specified in the corresponding column(3), in the table below:-

Single suite (without kitchen)	Rs. 4200 and above	Level 6 and above

(3) The calculation of date of priority and preparation of waiting lists for different types of accommodations shall be as under:

- (a) The date of priority in respect of type I to type IV accommodation shall be determined on the basis of the date of joining of the employee in the Central Government service and the eligibility for the type of accommodation shall be decided as per their level of the applicant in the pay matrix:

Provided that an applicant under this category shall be allowed to bid for one type lower accommodation than the type eligible for such.

- (b) An applicant referred to in clause (a) above who has served continuously at a particular station for a period of five years shall, on each such completion of five years as on 1st January of the year, be given one year edge over and above his date of joining in the Central Government service, for the purpose of calculation of his date of priority in the waiting list.

- (c) The date of priority in respect of type IV(S) and above accommodation shall be determined on the basis of the date from which the applicant has been continuously eligible for the type of accommodation as per the level of the applicant in the pay matrix.

- (d) The inter-se seniority for the type IV(S) and above accommodation shall be considered on the basis of the following factors, namely:-

(i) where the priority date of two or more applicants is the same, the applicant having a higher level pay in the level shall be senior in the waiting list;

(ii) where the date of priority and the pay in the level of two or more applicants are the same, the applicant who has joined the Central Government service earlier shall be senior in the waiting list; and

(iii) where the date of priority, pay in the level and the date of joining the Central Government service of two or more applicants are the same, the applicant retiring earlier may be accorded priority over the applicant retiring later.

- (e) The inter se seniority of applicants in the rank of Secretary and Additional Secretary to the Government of India shall be determined as per the civil list published for each service on the basis of their date of joining the Government of India at Delhi subject to the condition that no junior batch applicant of the same service or no junior applicant of the same batch and of same service shall get priority over his senior batch applicant or senior applicant in the same batch:

Provided that where the date of joining is the same, the applicant retiring earlier may be accorded priority over the officer retiring later:

Provided further that in respect of all other services other than the All India Services (AIS), the inter se seniority of applicants shall be determined on the basis of their date of joining the Government of India, irrespective of their place of posting and service or batch.

- (f) The applicants entitled for type V and above accommodation shall also be eligible to apply for accommodation below their entitlement subject to the condition that such accommodation shall not be below type IV Special accommodation:

Provided that the applicants eligible for type VA(D II) and Type IV (S) shall also be eligible to apply for type IV accommodation:

Provided further that where type V and type VI accommodation has not been classified as type VA and type VB or type VIA and type VIB, as the case may be, all eligible applicants for type V and type VI shall be grouped together in their respective types.

- (4) Personal Pay shall not be considered for the purposes of determining the inter-se seniority in the waiting list.

- (5) Non Practising Allowance, Military Service Pay or any other such component of pay shall not be considered for the purposes of determining the inter se seniority in the waiting list.

Subject : Fixation of pay in case of employees who seek transfer to a lower post under FR 15(a)- clarification regarding.

The undersigned is directed to refer to this Department's OM No.16/4/2012-Pay-I dated 5th November, 2012 read with OM No.13/9/2009-Estt.(Pay-I) dated 21st October, 2009, whereby clarification was issued by this Department for fixation of pay in case of employees seeking transfer to lower posts under FR 15(a) subsequent to the implementation of the recommendations of 6th CPC and CCS(RP) Rules, 2008. It was clarified therein that in case of transfer of a Government servant to a lower Grade Pay under FR 15(a) on his/her own request w.e.f. 1.1.2006, the pay in the Pay Band will be fixed at the stage equal to the pay in Pay Band drawn by him/her prior to his/her appointment against the lower post. However, he/she will be granted the Grade Pay of lower post. Further, in all cases, he/she will continue to draw his/her increment(s) based on his pay in the Pay Band +Grade Pay (lower).

2. Consequent upon the implementation of 7th CPC Report and CCS(RP)Rules, 2016, the concept of new Pay Matrix has replaced the existing Pay Bands and Grade Pays system. Accordingly, in partial modification of this Department's OMs dated 5th November, 2012 and 21st October, 2009 *ibid*, the method of pay fixation in respect of a Government Servant transferred to a lower post under FR 15(a) on his/her own request w.e.f 1.1.2016 will be as under:

'In case of transfer to a lower Level of post in the Pay Matrix under FR 15(a) on his/her own request w.e.f. 1.1.2016, the pay of the Government Servant holding a post on regular basis will be fixed in the revised pay structure at the stage equal to the pay drawn by him/her in the higher Level of post held regularly. If no such stage is available, the pay will be fixed at the stage next below in the lower Level with respect to the pay drawn by him/her in the higher Level of post held regularly and the difference in the pay may be granted as personal pay to be absorbed in future Increment(s). If maximum of the vertical range of pay progression at the lower Level in which he/she is appointed, happens to be less than the pay drawn by him/her in the higher Level, his/her pay may be restricted to that maximum under FR 22(I)(a)(3).

3. All Ministries/Departments are requested to revise the Terms/Conditions of such transfer, if any, in line with para 2 above.
4. In so far as persons serving in the Indian Audit and Accounts Department are concerned, these orders issue after consultation with the Comptroller & Auditor General of India.
5. This order takes effect from 1.1.2016.

G.S.R. 592(E).—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and clause (5) of article 148 of the Constitution and after consultation with the Comptroller and Auditor General in relation to persons serving in the Indian Audit and Accounts Department, the President hereby makes the following rules to amend the Central Civil Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 2016, namely:—

1. (1) These rules may be called the Central Civil Services (Revised Pay) (Amendment) Rules, 2017.

(2) They shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of January, 2016.

2. In the Central Civil Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 2016,—
(a) in rule 3, in clause (v), for the figures "2006", the figures "2016" shall be substituted

;

(b) in rule 12, for the words "the date of notification of these rules.", the following shall be substituted, namely:—

"1st January, 2016 and the same shall apply to the pay of officers coming on deputation to posts in the Central Government which are not covered under the Central Staffing Scheme.";

(c) in the Schedule,—

(i) for PART A, the following PART shall be substituted, namely:—
