Central Government Employees Group Insurance Scheme-1980-Tables of Benefits for the savings fund for the period from 1-1-2015 to 31-12-2015

The undersigned is directed to refer to this Ministry's O.M.No.7 (1)/E.V/2013, dated the 8th January, 2014 forwarding therewith Tables of Benefits under CGEGIS for the year 2014, New Tables of Benefits for the savings fund of the Scheme based on a subscription of Rs.10 per month from 1-1-1982 to 31-12-1989 and Rs.15 per month with effect from 1-1-1990 onwards have been prepared for the year 2015 and a copy of the table is enclosed. Another Table of Benefits for the savings fund based on a subscription of Rs.10 per month for those employees who had opted out of the revised rates of subscription with effect from 1-1-1990 have also been drawn up for the year 2015 and a copy of that table is also enclosed. The amounts in the Tables have been worked out on the basis of interest @ 10% per annum (compounded quarterly) for the 31-12-1982,11% per period from 1-1-1982 to annum(compounded quarterly) with effect from 1-1-1983 to 31-12-1986, 12% per annum(compounded quarterly) with effect from 1-1-1987 to 31-12-2000, 11% per annum(compounded quarterly) with effect from 1-1-2001 to 31-12-2001, 9.5% per annum(compounded quarterly) with effect from 1-1-2002 to 31-12-2002, 9.0% per annum(compounded quarterly) with effect from 1-1-2003 to 31-12-2003, 8% per annum(compounded quarterly) with effect from 1-1-20040 to 30-11-2011, 8.6% per annum(compounded quarterly) with effect from 1-12-2011 to 31-03-2012, 8.8% per annum(compounded quarterly) with effect from 1-4-2012 to 31-03-2013 and 8.7% per annum(compounded quarterly) with effect from 1-4-2013 onwards. The mortality rate under the Scheme has been taken as 3.75 per thousand per annum up to 31-12-1987 and 3.60 per thousand per annum thereafter in both the cases. While calculating the amount, it has been assumed that the subscription has been recovered or will be recovered from the salary of the month in which a member ceases to be service failing which it should be deducted from accumulated amounts payable.

Fresh empanelment of private Health Care Organizations (HCOs) and revision of package rates applicable under CGHS, Jaipur

The undersigned is directed to state that CGHS had initiated action for fresh empanelment of private HCOs under CGHS, Jaipur and also for the revision of package rates to be paid to HCOs, by floating tender for the same. On the basis of the responses received, rates for various procedures / treatments / investigations have been arrived at and have been uploaded on the website of CGHS: www.cghsjaipur.nic.in and can be downloaded from there. Similarly, a copy of the agreement containing the terms and conditions of empanelment has also been uploaded on the above quoted website of CGHS.

- 2. The approved list of the hospitals for empanelment under CGHS, Jaipur as per the terms and conditions of empanelment and MOA signed between CGHS and HCOs is enclosed.

5. (a) CS (MA) beneficiaries are entitled to facilities of private, semiprivate or general ward depending on their basic pay. The entitlement is as follows:—

- (b) The package rates given in rate list of CGHS are for semi-private ward.
- (c) The package rates prescribed are for semi-private ward. If the beneficiary is entitled for general ward, there will be a decrease of 10% in the rates; for private ward entitlement there will be an increase of 15%. However, the rates shall be same for investigation irrespective of entitlement, whether the patient is admitted or not and the test, per se, does not require admission.
- 6. The hospital shall charge from the beneficiary as per the CGHS prescribed rates or its own rate list, whichever is lower. The hospital shall charge CGHS Non-NABH Jaipur rates.
- 7. (a) The maximum room rent admissible for different categories would be:—

(b) Room rent mentioned above at (a) above is applicable only for treatment procedures for which there is no CGHS prescribed package rate.

Room rent will include charges for occupation of bed, diet for the patient, charges for water and electricity supply, linen charges, nursing charges and routine upkeeping.

- (c) During the treatment in ICCU / 1CU, no separate room rent will be admissible.
- (d) Private ward is defined as a hospital room where single patient is accommodated and which has an attached toilet (lavatory and bath). The room should have furnishings like wardrobe, dressing table, bed-side table, sofa set, etc. as well as a bed for attendant. The room has to be air-conditioned.
- (e) Semi Private ward is defined as a hospital room where two to three patients are accommodated and which has attached toilet facilities and necessary furnishings.

- 14. In case of treatment taken in emergency in any non-recognized private hospitals, reimbursement shall be considered by competent authority at CGHS prescribed package / rates only.
- 15. If one or more minor procedures form part of a major treatment procedure, then package charges would be permissible for major procedure and only 50% of charges for minor procedure.
- 16. Further, the Gheesi Bai Memorial Mittal Hospital and Research Centre, Ajmer (Rajasthan) shall undertake the pre-investigations / diagnostic tests / consultations / examinations as a service provider for conducting the Annual Medical Examination of the Civil Services, Group 'A' Officers of above 40 years of age as per the prescribed protocol for Annual Medical Examination, as per Annexure (not printed).
- 17. The hospital will not charge the Central Government employees who come for Annual Medical Examination more than ₹2,000 for conducting the prescribed medical examinations of the male officers and ₹2,200 for female officers, who come to the hospital with the requisite permission letter from their Department / Ministry concerned. The above rates for Annual Medical Examination are valid until such time when the above rates are revised by the Central by the Government.
- 18. Any legal liability arising out of such services shall be the sole responsibility and shall be dealt with by the concerned empanelled hospital. Services will be provided by the Hospital as per the terms given above.
- 19. Ministry of Health and Family Welfare reserves the right to withdraw / cancel the above recognition without assigning any reason.
 - 20. The order takes effect from the date of issue of the O.M.
- 21. The authorities of Gheesi Bai Memorial Mittal Hospital and Research Centre, Ajmer (Rajasthan) will have to enter into an agreement with the Government of India to the effect that the Hospital will charge from the Central Government employees at the rates fixed by the Government and they will have to sign a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) within a period of 3 months from the date of issue of the abovementioned OM failing which the Hospital will be derecognized (Two original copies of MOU duly signed by the Hospital to be sent for acceptance). Subject to above, the hospital can start treating Central Government employees covered under CS (MA) Rules, 1944.

Annual Medical Examination for the Group 'A' Officers of Central Civil services/posts of age 40 years and above

The undersigned is directed to refer to this Department's O.M.of even number, dated the 1st February. 2012 and 20th March, 2013 on the above subject whereby the scheme of Annual Medical Examination in respect of Group 'A' Officers of Central Civil services/posts of age 40 years and above had been circulated in consultation with Ministry of Health and family Welfare. In this OM, the regime of medical tests to be conducted, the package rates applicable and the list of 26 Hospitals which had agreed to conduct the Annual Medical Examination under the Scheme were prescribed. Subsequently, vide O M of even number, dated the 20th March,2013, full address of the 26 Hospitals in Delhi/NCR circulated with OM dated the 1st February,2012, was notified.

- 2. In O.M.No.21011/1/2009-Estt-(A), Part, dated the 20th March,2013, the list of empanelled Hospitals in the areas other than Delhi NCR as provided by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare vide their O.M.No.A.17020/1/2010-MS, dated the 28th December,2012, was attached
- 3. The matter regarding empanelment of hospitals for the required Medical Examination was again taken up by this Department with Ministry of Health and Family Welfare.
- 4. Ministry of Health and Family Welfare vide O.M. No. S. 11045/36/2012-CGHS (HEC), dated the 1st October, 2014 (Sl. No. 205 of SwamysnewS, November, 2014) have conveyed the details of fresh empanelment of private Health Care Organizations (HCO) and revision of package rates applicable under CGHS. Delhi and NCR which are valid for two years. This OM, dated the 1st October, 2014 can be downloaded from their website www.mohfw.nic.in\cghsnew\index.asp. With this OM, dated the 1st October, 2014, a list of approved Private Health Care Organisation (HCOs), which are empanelled under CGHS in Delhi / NCR area, has also been enclosed (not printed).
- 5. In accordance with Para. 3 (M) of the agreement entered into by the Ministry of Health and FW with these Hospitals (copy enclosed with their above mentioned O.M. No. S. 11045/36/2012-CGHS (HEC), dated the 1st October, 2014), it has been made obligatory for these Hospitals to

conduct Annual Medical Examination as per the prescribed format and approved rates. The agreement has provided that these empanelled Hospitals shall agree for conducting all investigations / diagnostic tests / consultation, etc. of the Central Civil Service, Group 'A' Officer of above 40 years of age and other categories of CGHS beneficiaries as specified by Government from time to time as per the prescribed protocol, subject to the condition that the hospital shall not charge more than ₹ 2,000 for conducting the prescribed medical examination of the male officers and ₹ 2,200 for female officers of Central Government who come to the hospital / institution with the requisite permission letter from their Department / Ministry / Competent Authority. Accordingly, Group 'A' officers of Central Civil Services / Posts of age of 40 years and above can have the required Annual Medical Examination conducted by the Hospitals listed with the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare's above referred No. S. 11045/36/2012-CGHS (HEC), dated the 1st October, 2014 referred in Para. 4 above.

6. In non-CGHS areas, the number of hospitals empanelled under CS (MA) Rules, 1944 being relatively lower, the different departments / offices may identify one or more hospital locally and refer their Group 'A' Officers to such hospital for annual medical examination as per the prescribed schedule and rate i.e. ₹ 2,000 for men and ₹ 2,200 for women officers. State Government hospitals or semi-Government / Public Sector Undertakings (PSU) hospitals may also be contacted for the purpose accordingly.

Modified Assured Career Progression Scheme for the Central Government Civilian Employees - Instructions

The Department on the recommendation of Sixth Central Pay Commission in Para.6.1.15 of its report and in supersession of previous Assured Career Progression Scheme, vide O.M.No.35034/3/2008-Estt.(D), dated 19-5-2009 introduced the Modified Assured Career Progression Scheme(MACPS) for the Central Government Civilian Employees which is operational with effect from 1-9-2008. MACP Scheme envisages the three financial up gradations at intervals of 10, 20 and 30 years of continuous regular service to all regularly appointed Group 'A', 'B' and 'C' Central Government Civilian Employees.

- 2. As per Para. 6 of DoP&T's, O.M. No. 35034/3/2008-Estt. (D), dated 19-5-2009, the Screening Committee would follow a time-schedule and meet twice in a financial year-preferably in the first week of *January* and first week of *July* of a year for advance processing of the cases maturing in that half. Accordingly, cases maturing during the first-half (April-September) of a particular financial year would be taken up for consideration by the Screening Committee meeting in the first week of January. Similarly, the Screening Committee meeting in the first week of July of any financial year would process the cases that would be maturing during the second-half (October-March) of the same financial year.
- 3. It has come to notice of this Department that the benefits of MACPS are not being granted as per the schedule/provisions in the MACP Scheme leading to dissatisfaction and grievances among the employees. Therefore, Ministrie / Departments are advised to ensure strict compliance to the time limits indicated in MACPS for grant of benefits under this scheme as and when the employees become eligible for such benefits.

G.I., Dept. of Per. & Trg., O.M. No. 31941/2/2015-Estt. (A-IV), dated 27-1-2015

Travel by Premium Trains on LTC — Clarification

The undersigned is directed to say that several references are received by this Department from various Ministries / Departments seeking clarification regarding admissibility of travel by Premium Trains run by Indian Railways while availing of LTC.

2. The matter has been examined in consultation with Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance and it has been decided that travel by Premium Trains is not permissible on LTC. Hence, the fare charged by the Indian Railways for the journey(s) performed by Premium Trains shall not be reimbursable for the purpose of LTC. Cases where LTC travel in such Premium Trains has already been undertaken by the Central Government Employees, the train fare may be reimbursed restricting it to the admissible normal fare for the entitled class of-train travel or the actual fare paid, whichever is less.

G.I., Dept. of Per. & Trg., O.M.No.14028/2/2012-Estt.(L), dated 9-2-2015

Encashment of earned leave along with LTC - Clarification

The undersigned is directed to refer to DoP&T's O.M.No.31011/4/2008-Estt. (A), dated the 23rd September,2008 allowing encashment of earned leave along with LTC and to say that references have been received with regard to the number if times that a Government servant can avail of the encashment within the same block.

2. It is clarified that the Government servants governed by the CCS(Leave)Rules, 1972 and entitled to avail LTC may encash earned leave upto 10 days at the time of availing both types of LTCs i.e. 'Hometown' and 'anywhere in India'. However, when the one and the same LTC is being availed of by the Government servant and his family members separately in a block year, encashment of leave would be restricted to one occasion only.
