Clarification of Deferred withdrawal of lumpsum

PFRDA (Exits and Withdrawals from National Pension System) Regulations, 2015 provides option to subscriber to defer withdrawal of lumpsum (60%) up to the age of 70 years.

Under the Deferred withdrawal facility, the subscribers at the time of exit from National Pension System (NPS) can exercise an option to defer the withdrawal of eligible lumpsum withdrawal and stay invested in the NPS. Subscriber has an option to withdraw the deferred lumpsum amount in maximum ten annual instalments up to the age of 70 years or withdraw the entire amount at once by giving 15 days advance notice during such a period of deferment. If no such notice is given, the accumulated pension wealth would be automatically monetized and credited to his bank account upon attaining the age of 70 years.

**Court Orders against DoP&PW Government of India Instructions
on service matters - Consultation with Ministry of Law and
DoP&PW on the question of filing appeals before
implementation of Court's orders**

The undersigned is directed to say that it has come to the notice of this Department that in some cases where the Courts have passed orders against the Government of India, the administrative Ministry/Department has not consulted this Department on the question of filing appeal against such orders, before implementation of such orders.

2. Instructions have been issued from time to time that whenever there is any Court order against the Government of India instructions on service matters, the administrative Ministry/Department/Office, shall consult the Department of Legal Affairs, Department of Personnel and Training and the Department of Pension and Pensioners' Welfare on the question of filing appeal against such an order before the time-limit, if any, prescribed in such order or before the time-limit for filing appeal under the rules.

3. It is therefore, reiterated that in all cases where any policy issue relating to pension matters is involved, the Department of Pension and Pension Welfare should invariably be consulted before taking a decision on the question of implementation or otherwise of any order of a Court. No such order shall be implemented by the concerned Departments/Ministries without first referring the matter to this Department for advice.

4. In order to avoid any delay in processing of such matters, administrative Ministry/Department can consult this Department for any advice by personally visiting to this Department from 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. on every Wednesday.

**Modification in the format of Life Certificate – Issue of
Acknowledgement to pensioners**

Attention is invited to this office O.M.No.CPAO/Tech./Simplification/2012-13/325, dated 18-2-2013 directing the banks to allow pensioners/family pensioners to submit the life certificates as well as other certificates to any branch of the bank through which their pension are being disbursed. In this context, several instances of stoppage of payment of pensions have been reported citing non-receipt of life certificate even though the pensioners had submitted their life certificates to the bank, due to misplacement of the life certificate at the bank branches concerned. Instances of some pension paying banks not accepting life certificates given to them by pensioners and directing pensioners to submit the life certificate to CPPC have also been reported causing great inconvenience to pensioners, which results in either stoppage of payment of pension or delay in payment of pension.

In this context, to alleviate the hardship faced by the pensioners, RBI has also instructed all the Agency Banks handling Government pension payment, *vide* Notfn. No. RBI/2014-15/587 DGBA, GAD No. H-5013/45.01.001/2014-15, dated 7-5-2015 that on receipt of Life Certificate submitted in physical form, banks to issue duly signed acknowledgement to the pensioners and to enter the same in their CBS immediately and issue a system generated receipt to serve the twin purpose of acknowledgement to the pensioners as well as real-time updation of records.

To facilitate the bank authorities, CPAO has prescribed a modified format of life certificate providing therewith acknowledgement of the receipt of the life certificate *vide* Correction Slip No. 24 to the Scheme for Payment of Pensions to Central Government Civil Pensioners by Authorized Banks. The acknowledgement is a part of the format of Life Certificate, which can be detached and given to the pensioner by the receiving bank. The format (Annexure) has been circulated to all concerned and the same has been made available on CPAO's website www.cpao.nic.in at the link "For Banks" → Guidelines for Master data.

The Chairmen/Chief Executive Directors of Authorized Banks are requested to ensure that their paying branches follow the above instructions scrupulously without fail.

**Grant of dearness Relief to CPF beneficiaries in receipt of
ex gratia payment with effect from 1-7-2015**

In continuation of this Department's O.M.No.42/10/2014-P&PW (G), dated the 26th May, 2015, the President is pleased to grant the Dearness Relief at the rate of Fifth CPC with effect from 1-7-2015 to the following:

- (i) The surviving CPF beneficiaries who have retired from service between the period 18-11-1960 to 31-12-1985 and are in receipt of ex gratia @ Rs.600kp.m. with effect from 1-11-1997 under this Department's O.M.No.45/52/97-P&PW(E), dated 16-12-1997 and revised to Rs.3000, Rs.1000, Rs.750 and Rs.650 for Groups 'A', 'B', 'C' and 'Dated' respectively with effect from 4th June, 2013 vide O.M.No.1/10/2012-P&PW(E), dated the 27th June, 2013 vide O.M.No.1/10/2012-P&PW(E), dated the 27th June, 2013 are entitled to dearness Relief @234% with effect from 1-7-2015.
- (ii) The following categories of CPF beneficiaries who are in receipt of ex gratia payment in terms of this Department's O.M.No.45/52/97-P&PW(E), dated 16-12-1997 are entitled to DR @ 226% with effect from 1-7-2015:
 - (a) The widows and dependent children of the deceased CPF beneficiary who had retired from service prior to 1-1-1986 or who had died while in service prior to 1-1-1986 and are in receipt of ex gratia payment of Rs.605 p.m. and revised to Rs.645p.m. with effect from 4th June, 2013 vide O.M.No.1/10/2012-P&PW (E), dated the 27th June, 2013.
 - (b) Central Government employees who had retired on CPF benefits before 18-11-1960 and are in receipt of ex gratia payment of Rs.654, Rs.659, Rs.703 and Rs.965.

2. Payment of DR involving a fraction of a rupee shall be rounded off to the next higher rupee. In their application to the Indian Audit and Accounts Department, these orders issue in consultation with the C&AG.

3. This issues as per Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure vide their O.M.No.1 (4)/E.V/2004, dated 25-5-2015 and O.M.No.1 (3)/2008-E.II (B), dated 1-10-2015.

Revision of pension of pre-2006 Central Civil Pensioners and providing better service to pensioners

Consequent upon the implementation of Sixth CPC, revision of pensions of Pre-2006 pensioners were made *suo motu* by banks as per ready reckoner provided by Department of Pensions and Pensioners' Welfare with effect from 1-1-2006. For regularizing these revisions and updating the records of Pension Sanctioning Authority, Pay and Accounts Office and Central Pension Accounting Office; Pension Payment Orders (PPO) were to be issued through proper channel, i.e. Head of Office → PPO → CPAO → Bank. But considerable number of pension cases are still pending for revision by Government for want of certain information like last pay drawn, scale of pay, qualifying service, date of birth, date of death, current pension account number, contact number, etc. which are not readily available either with Pension Sanctioning Authority or with the Banks.

As the recommendations of the Seventh CPC are due very shortly, it is imperative to settle all these pending cases before so that while implementing the recommendations of Seventh CPC, pension may be revised expeditiously.

In this context, it is presumed that the Central Civil Pensioners' Associations remain in touch with pensioners and they may facilitate

in pursuing the pensioners to provide their latest addresses, telephone numbers, e-mail IDs while submitting their Life Certificates (Format of Life Certificate enclosed - *not printed* - See Annexure-XVII to Sl. No. 250 in this issue) to the bank in the month of November, 2015 so that the pensioners may be contacted to get the required information.

In view of the above, Secretaries of all Central Civil Pensioners' Associations are requested to extend their support in making contact with pensioners and pursue them to provide the necessary information while submitting Life Certificates to enable us to serve them better.
