Subject: Revision of pay scales.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to this Ministry's letter of even number dated 3rd November, 1987 in which it was stated in clarification No.2 that those teachers who were already in the pre-revised selection grade (recommended by the 4th Pay Commission), will be placed in the senior scale. It was further clarified in clarification No.3 that selection scale (revised) is to be given to those who have completed 12 years of service in the senior scale of the grade. A question came up for consideration as to whether the period of service in the senior scale should be counted w.e.f. 1.1.86 or from the date of grant of pre-revised selection grade. Since it has

already been decided to place those teachers who were in the pre-revised selection grade in the newly introduced senior scale. it is clarified that the service in the pre-revised selection grade may be counted as service in the revised senior scale for the purpose of grant of selection scale.
